Narrative

This project upgraded two general assignment classrooms in the Architecture Building. Room 120 received very heavy general assignment class traffic. Its finishes and furnishings were worn, damaged and deteriorated. Room 210A was significantly underutilized due to room condition and classroom IT inadequacies.

The project either replaced or reconditioned aged & rapidly deteriorating **seating and flooring** in room 120. The project also **installed a classroom IT system, mitigated water infiltration issues, repainted the walls and ceiling, and addressed heating control complaints** in room 210A.

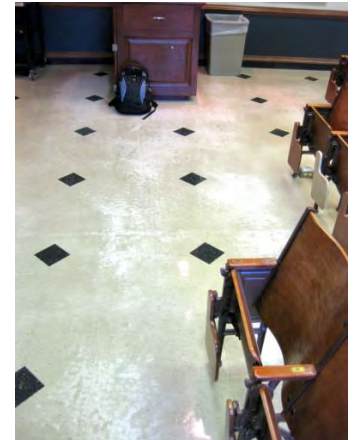
With the completion of this project, room 210A can now provide much-needed IT equipped instructional space.
