## Room 166 & 168 Remodel

### Building Information

**Year Built:** 1956

**Project Area Primary Users:** General assign.

**Affected Rooms:** 166 & 168

**Room Capacities:** 75 seats

### Narrative

This project combined and converted two rooms previously used as a conference room and a classroom to be utilized as a new 75-seat general assignment classroom. The larger of these rooms (166) was provided with temporary furnishings for class use, but the fixtures are aged & worn, and the room is still in need of significant remodeling for finishes, furnishings, and equipment.



The project **removed the wall that was between rooms 166 & 168**, combining them into a single, large class space. The project involved **removing carpeting & office furnishings**, conducting an **asbestos abatement**, **upgrading floor and wall finishes**, and **modifying exits to meet the required standards** for classrooms. It also **purchased & installed classroom furniture** such as seating, an instructor's desk, white-boards, and a **classroom IT system**.

It will provide an additional general assignment class space, helping to address current scheduling constraints and a shortage of technology-equipped class spaces.
